I am running for a vacancy on the Board in Section A. I have been a member since 2006. I have been retired for many years from LANXESS Corp (a spinoff of Bayer Corp) as a Customer Service Manager. I had managed a group of Customer Service Representative and a budget of \$1,140,000. I have 3 married children and 5 grandchildren. I graduated from Robert Morris University with a B.S. Business Administration, Logistics Management in 2000.

I do not have an agenda other than to offer the campground and the Board my experience and knowledge that I have gained since 2012 while serving on the Board. I was a Director for Section A from June 2012 to September 2019. Also served as Secretary for the Board from 2013-2019.
