I have been in the camp since 2005

Why are you running: Try to make the campground a better place.

I now serve on ten different committees which I am active on all of them. I have been on most of these committees for 11 plus years which includes maintenance, finance, by-laws, rules, membership nominating, safety, newsletter, co-chair of pool and land use.

I served two terms on the board where I was chair of Maintenance For four of the six years made sure we had critical spare parts. Our staff remodeled A bath house. Revamped the floors in the other bath houses. Had the equipment worked on to make sure it was in working order. Lined up to have the outdated transformers replaced. There are still five that need replaced. Helped get a leaf vac, etc.
