Non-Negotiable Lanyards- It has been brought to my attention that a few people disagree with the lanyards, I do not understand why anyone would question any measure to ensure another step in the safety of children! *If you don't volunteer, then you don't have to wear a lanyard. If you want to volunteer, then you must wear the lanyard!* You have freedom of choice, and we respect your decision!



Fob shut off-April 1st is 7 days away

Art II, Sec 4 a. If not paid by April 1, their gate fobs are deactivated, and **they are suspended from the campground.**

Suspended member: If they are found in the park and they are suspended, they cannot return until they have a hearing with the Board. (even if they want to pay in full before the hearing)

Art II Section 4. (a) A member who fails to pay any Assessment by the date set by the Board of Directors shall be automatically suspended from membership of the Association.

POLICY 1: Membership dues are payable on October 1. Payment in full must be received or postmarked on or before December 31. Thereafter, there will be a \$25.00 late charge assessed the first day of each month until the account is paid in full. **If the membership dues and all financial obligations are not paid by April 1,** gate fobs will be deactivated.

Assessments are payable as determined by the Board of Directors. Thereafter, there will be a \$25.00 late charge assessed the first day of each month until the account is paid in full. If the assessment and all financial obligations are not paid by the date set by the Board of Director, gate fobs will be deactivated.

Fobs will be shut off for nonpayment. Any member whose fob has been cut off and found in the campground will result in immediate suspension until a board hearing. This includes members who perform work in the campground. **No member should allow anyone in the**

campground with their fob! If a member says I lost my fob, pull up to the gate and talk into the speaker, you can come to the office and get a replacement.

Monetary Donations- All donations to any committee must be submitted to the office so that financials reflect the donation. This is the only way to donate.



Collections for any committee- If you purchase items for an event and need to be reimbursed you must obtain a form from the committee chair. No reimbursements will be made unless the form has been signed and submitted. All forms with receipts submitted will be paid with the next set of business checks. There is not any immediate reimbursement.



Dogs-barking- not on leashes- We have had several instances of Dogs off leashes, wandering into neighbor's yards, wandering the campground. All pets must be contained to your lot or on a leash if off your lot. Dogs incessantly barking infringes on other members

peace and enjoyment of camp. It is your responsibility to keep your pet from being a nuisance or issue.



Lot cleaning- We have 11 lots that are in every consideration deplorable, we have over 100 that desperately need to be pressure washed, we have 300 that need a basic clean up and organization, we have 400 that need a touch up, and we have the rest that just need basic lawn care. There are at least 100 that have been cleaned and made beautiful, and we are so appreciative of your diligence in making it a priority. We understand that many of you are still soaking up the sun in the south. Please remember the opening checklist, follow the rules, and ensure you are not the Sanford and Son lot ruining your neighbor's eyesight!



Opening Season Checklist!

Make sure that all your contact information is up to date. (Phone numbers, email addresses, mailing addresses.)

Cut grass – must be done by May 15th

Take tarps off trailers – must be done by May 15th

Golf cart registration stickers – due by Memorial Day

Must either be on the windshield like an inspection sticker or along the driver's

side of the golf cart

Lot # stickered on the top left corner of your trailer

Lot # stickered on the front and back of your golf cart

Clean trailer exterior

No mold or dirt on the outside of the trailer

Get permit applications in!

If you're planning a project to do over the summer, submit your permit application ASAP to ensure that it's approved before you have a vendor scheduled to come in – contact office staff for any questions or details on the permit process

Send any pet vaccination records over to Stephanie at manager@srcahome.com if you haven't already

If she already has all your pet records, disregard this step

Remember that all pets must be on a leash if they aren't in a fenced enclosure on your lot, per the Pennsylvania leash law. This applies everywhere in the campground.

Pick up a copy of the weekly/yearly schedule!

Pick up the updated copy of the Rules & Policies

Refresh your memory on any rules and learn any updates that may have been made

If you have any kids under 12, stop by the office to pick up a safety flag for **\$3** to attach to their bikes, scooters, etc. This helps keep your kids safe and visible when riding around on the roads!
